I am writing in the context of making use of the facilities available at "Sports Injury Centre" Safdurjung Hospital, New Delhi-by sportspersons.

02. Sports Injury Centre after its inauguration on 26.09.2010, has been providing comprehensive diagnostic, surgical and rehabilitative services under one roof for sports-related injuries and joint disorders. The facilities include three world class ultra clean air, state of art Modular Operation Theatres and a dedicated team of Surgeons, Anesthetists, Sports Medicine Specialists, Physiotherapists, Nurses and other trained Para-medical staff. The Centre has excelled in providing optimal surgical procedures in Arthroscopy involving knee, shoulder, elbow, wrist and ankle joints. Apart from this, Joint replacement surgeries for knee and hip joint arthritis are also being done here. More than 5000 successful surgeries have been undertaken during the last two years and the patients have been able to get back to their normal levels of activity.

The Centre has a modern Physiotherapy Department which includes gym facilities for Cardio & Strength training, a Hydrotherapy unit consisting of Sauna bath, Chill shower, Steam bath and a Pool for faster recovery, Electrotherapy unit equipped with the latest and most modern equipments to ensure pre and post-operative rehabilitation along with the facility for Isokinetic testing for muscular strength, endurance testing and rehabilitation.

On the diagnostic side, Radiology facilities available in the Centre includes a 50 slice CT scanner and the 1.5 Tesla GE MRI X-ray, Bone Densitometry etc. The Pathological Laboratory at SIC is equipped with the latest equipment to ensure standards at par with international level. Both these services run on PPP mode ensuring prompt and efficient services at highly concessional CGHS approved rates.

05. I shall request you to give wide publicity to the facilities available at the Sports Injury Centre and bring the same to the notice of sportspersons. A copy of the brochure giving details of the facilities available at the Sports Injury Centre is enclosed. It would be in the interest of sports in the country to make full use of the state-of-art facilities that exist in the Centre.
